



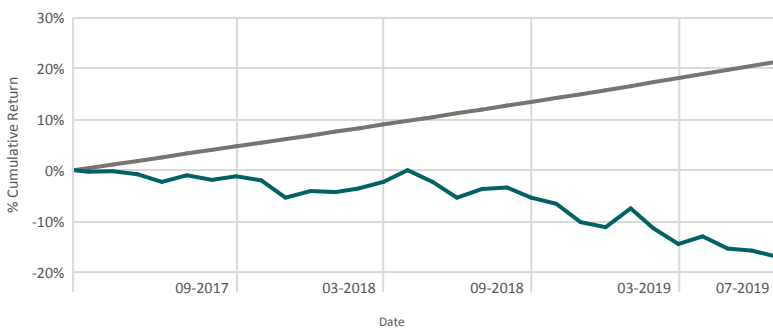
+ INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

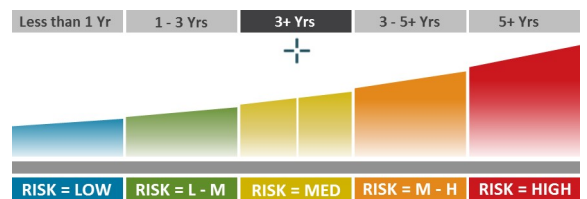
